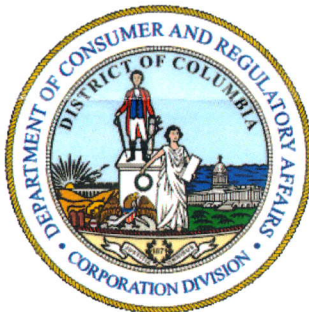

**STATEMENT OF ELECTION TO ACCEPT
OF
WOMEN'S ARMY CORPS VETERANS' ASSOCIATION**

To: The Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, Washington, D.C.

Pursuant to the provisions of the District of Columbia Non-profit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation elects to avail itself thereto.

- FIRST:** The name of the corporation is the Women's Army Corps Veterans' Association ("WACVA").
- SECOND:** A resolution recommending that WACVA accept the District of Columbia Non-profit Corporation Act was adopted in the following manner: the resolution was adopted at a meeting of the National Board of Directors held on August 30, 2007, at which a quorum was present, and received the vote of two-thirds of the Directors in office, there being no members having voting rights in respect thereof.
- THIRD:** The exclusive, specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is organized, and for which it shall be administered and operated, are to receive, administer, and expend funds in connection with the following:
- A. A continuing commitment on a national basis to promote the general welfare of all veterans, especially women veterans, who have served or are serving in the United States Army, the Army Reserve and the Army National Guard.
 - B. A continuing commitment on a national basis to recognize outstanding women in college ROTC units.
 - C. To provide services and support to patients in medical facilities of the Department of Veterans Affairs throughout the United States.
 - D. To provide civic betterment programs for the general welfare of the community.
 - E. To provide social and recreational activities for members.
- FOURTH:** WACVA shall have members.
- FIFTH:** WACVA shall have four classes of members. The description of each class of members; the qualifications, rights and limitations of the members of each class; and the voting rights (if any) of the members of each class are as follows:
- A. **Active Members:** Active members shall have the right to vote within their chapter, pay dues to their chapter (or to the National Headquarters for members-at-large), and hold office. Active members include those personnel who have served honorably with the Women's Army Auxiliary

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Corps, the Women's Army Corps, or those who have served or are serving honorably with the United States Army, the United States Army Reserve, or the Army National Guard of the United States. Such eligibility will be established by presentation of one or more of the following documents to a local chapter for potential chapter membership and to the National Headquarters for potential members-at-large.

1. DD Form 214 (Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge) or corresponding form of earlier series, or Certificate of Service;
2. Official Retirement Orders;
3. An initial statement from the current custodian of the applicant's personnel records, or her current Company Commander, certifying her active duty status is being served under honorable conditions, which will be presented by the applicant at the time she applies for or renews her membership in the Association; or
4. Upon separation from active duty, the member will furnish a copy of her DD Form 214 or an Honorable Discharge/ Certificate of Service to her chapter for verification of separation under honorable conditions or in the case of a member-at-large, to the appropriate national office that is in charge of maintaining the members-at-large records.

B. **Honorary Members.** Honorary membership, the recipients of which shall be without a vote, shall not pay dues, and shall not hold office, may be given upon approval of the National Executive Board to:

1. Mothers of members of WACVA provided they are not otherwise eligible for membership;
2. Women who have performed outstanding or exceptional service to WACVA who are not otherwise eligible for membership; and
3. Honorary membership may be conferred by local chapters with approval of the local Chapter Executive Board; and

C. **Associate Membership:** Associate membership may be extended by local chapters to members in good standing in other chapters when said members are in temporary residence in the area of the chapter extending the courtesy. Associate members shall not have a vote or hold office. Dues for associate members will be determined by the local chapter.

D. **Affiliate Membership:** Affiliate membership includes women that have served or are currently serving in any other branch of military service. Affiliate members shall not have a vote or hold office. The local chapter will determine dues for affiliate members.

SIXTH: The method and manner by which the Directors are elected and appointed shall be as provided in the bylaws.

SEVENTH: Provisions for the regulations of the internal affairs of WACVA shall be as provided in the Bylaws. Provisions for distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation shall be as provided in the Bylaws and the Articles of Incorporation.

EIGHTH: The address, including street and number, of its registered office in the District of Columbia is CT Corporation System, and the name of its registered agent at such address is 1015 15th St. NW, Suite 1000, Washington D.C.

NINTH: The names of WACVA's officers and directors (and the directors consist of the current National Officers, Chairpersons of all Standing Committees, Captain of the Honor Guard, Chairperson of the Member-at-Large Delegates, Presidents of each Chapter and all Past National Presidents), all of whom may be reached at WACVA's national office, located at 680 Galloway Road, Ft. McClellan, Alabama 36205-5577, are:
